1 **WHEREAS**, Howard County has many historic structures which, if properly preserved,
2 can provide the County’s neighborhoods with local landmarks and a strengthened sense of
3 identity; and

4
5 **WHEREAS**, the County has taken many steps to protect historic resources, including
6 creating historic districts, granting tax credits for the restoration and rehabilitation of historic
7 structures, and entering into certain cooperative agreements; and

8
9 **WHEREAS**, the grant of certain tax credits is expressly conditioned on the subject
10 property being included on the list of historic sites in the County; and

11
12 **WHEREAS**, the Zoning Regulations define “Historic Structure” as one that is designated
13 by Resolution of the County Council as having significant historical or architectural value; and

14
15 **WHEREAS**, previous versions of the Historic Sites Inventory have been adopted by the
16 Council by reference in the 1982, 1990, and 2000 General Plans, and by Resolution in 2000; and

17
18 **WHEREAS**, in 2004, the Council adopted Council Resolution No. 98-2004 wherein they
19 adopted the most recent Historic Sites Inventory (the “Inventory”); and

20
21 **WHEREAS**, in 2007 and 2008, the Council supplemented the Inventory by adopting
22 Council Resolution No. 117-2007 and Council Resolution No. 98-2008, respectively; and

24 **WHEREAS**, now the Department of Planning and Zoning wishes to add certain
25 properties, as listed in the attached Exhibit A, to the Inventory; and

27 **WHEREAS**, the owners of the structures proposed to be added to the Inventory have
28 been notified of their inclusion.

30 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the County Council of Howard County,
31 Maryland this ____ day of _____, 2011 that it supplements the Howard County

1 Historic Sites Inventory, as adopted in Council Resolution No. 98-2004 and as supplemented by
2 Council Resolution No. 117-2007 and Council Resolution No. 98-2008, with the properties listed
3 in the attached Exhibit A.

5 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, by the County Council of Howard County,
6 Maryland, that the entire Historic Sites Inventory may be amended and supplemented by
7 subsequent Resolution of the County Council.
