1 **WHEREAS**, Section 610 of the Howard County Charter authorizes and
2 empowers the Howard County Council to make supplementary appropriations from the
3 unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget;

6 **WHEREAS**, as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, the United
7 States Department of Energy, through the State of Maryland, Department of Housing and
8 Community Development (DHCD), has awarded Howard County a grant in the amount
9 of \$1,140,723 from DHCD's Weatherization Assistance Program; and

11 **WHEREAS**, grant funding will be used to assist eligible low income families
12 within Howard County to lower their energy costs by increasing the energy efficiency of
13 their homes, while ensuring their health and safety; and

15 **WHEREAS**, priority is given to homeowners who are elderly or disabled and to
16 families with children or to households that have high energy consumption; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be
19 transferred is not encumbered and is available for transfer.
