1           **WHEREAS**, Council Resolution No. 28-2009 sets forth the Fiscal Year 2010 Operating  
2 Budget for the Howard County Board of Education and was adopted with amendments on May  
3 20, 2009; and

5           **WHEREAS**, subsequent to the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2010 Operating Budget, the  
6 Board of Education received certain funding pursuant to the American Recovery and  
7 Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) in the amount of \$5,058,723 (the “ARRA funds”); and

9           **WHEREAS**, the Board of Education desires to amend its Fiscal Year 2010 Operating  
10 Budget to include the ARRA funds in a Restricted ARRA State Stabilization Fund for the  
11 purpose of meeting certain ARRA grant requirements; and

13           **WHEREAS**, also subsequent to the adoption of its FY 2010 Budget, the Board of  
14 Education has determined for which purposes the ARRA funds may be spent and desires to  
15 amend its FY 2010 Budget to show the ARRA funds as expenditures from the Restricted ARRA  
16 State Stabilization Fund; and

18           **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 5-105 of the Education Article of the Annotated Code  
19 of Maryland, the County Council must approve the source, amount and manner of spending for  
20 any nonlocal funds received after the adoption of the budget; and

22           **WHEREAS**, the ARRA funds are to be used for summer school wages, National Board  
23 Certification stipends, tuition reimbursement, workshops and social security.

25           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the County Council of Howard County,

27 manner of spending for ARRA funding received by the Board of Education in the amount of
