1           **WHEREAS**, Section 610 of the Howard County Charter authorizes and  
2 empowers the Howard County Council to make supplementary appropriations from the  
3 unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget;

6           **WHEREAS**, as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, the  
7 Governor’s Office of Crime Control and Prevention has awarded the “DNA Collection  
8 and Analysis Grant” to the County; and

10           **WHEREAS**, grant funds have been awarded in the amount of \$74,375; and

12           **WHEREAS**, grant funding will be used to pay costs associated with the  
13 processing of DNA samples collected at crime scenes; and

15           **WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be  
16 transferred is not encumbered and is available for transfer.
