1 **Section 1. Be It Enacted** by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that
2 paragraph (5) of subsection (b) of Section 1.306 “Executive exempt” of Subtitle 3 “Pay
3 plan” of Title 1 “Human Resources” of the Howard County Code is amended to read as
4 follows:

9 **Section 1.306. Executive exempt.**

10 (b) *Appointing Authorities.* Appointing authorities for executive exempt employees are
11 as provided in this subsection.

12 (5) *Fire and Rescue Services.* The Chief of Fire and Rescue Services, with the
13 approval of the County Executive, is the appointing authority for the
14 [[Assistant]] DEPUTY Chief¹.

18 ¹A Howard County classified employee appointed to this position automatically reverts to
19 the employee's prior rank in the classified service upon removal from the position, unless
20 the removal is based upon such cause as would justify the termination of a classified
21 employee.

23 **Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted** by the County Council of Howard County,
24 Maryland, that this Act shall apply beginning with the first pay date after July 1, 2010.

25

26 **Section 3. And Be It Further Enacted** by the County Council of Howard County,
27 Maryland, that this Act shall become effective 61 days after its enactment.
